Subject: You may be eligible for Retroactive Stop Loss Special Pay (RSLSP), \$500 a month. As a recipient of funds under the G.I. Bill, the following message may apply to you. Service Members involuntarily held under Stop Loss Authority between 11 September 2001 and 30 September 2008 qualifies for RSLSP. Those eligible will receive \$500 for every month spent in a stop loss status. Those who served in the Army should apply for the special day at <https://www.stoplosspay.army.mil>.

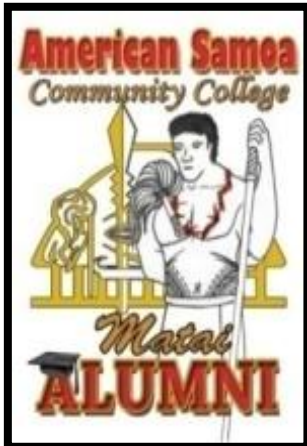
